When launching Tracker, SymbianWare declared; "All phones are equal, but owners are different."

Hence this, they made their Tracker software so that everyone could make exactly their own skin, leaving everyone with endless possibilities of making everyday use of UIQ based devices easier.

First and foremost this freedom has been used to create millions of skins varying over computer platform interfaces such as Windows XP, MacOS X etc.

In strive to create the most look-a-like skin, developers have lost track of what Tracker originally was intended for; simplicity.

This is my first skin for Tracker. Before I started making it, I decided that the original intentions behind the software were to be put forward. I would create something extraordinary with most simplicity.

These two words; extraordinary and simplicity have, for many years, been the trademark of renowned Danish HI-FI manufacturer Bang & Olufsen.

Therefore, it was quite natural for me to look at the Struer based company's many products.

Inspired from their products in common, and their Beoplayer (www.beoplayer.com) in particular, I created the BEOMOTO skin for Tracker 4.

Incorporating the two essences of Tracker and B&O this skin gives UIQ devices what has been long awaited; Simple navigation with extraordinary design.

I hope you enjoy using it, as much as I enjoyed making it!

Tracker 4 and BEOMOTO skin may work on other Symbian UIQ devices, but this is not tested, and the author of this product does not recommend installing it onto any other devices than the above specified.

The BEOMOTO skin requires Tracker 4 from SymbianWare to work. Older versions of Tracker are not supported by the BEOMOTO skin. Check your version of Tracker before installing the BEOMOTO skin.

INSTALLATION

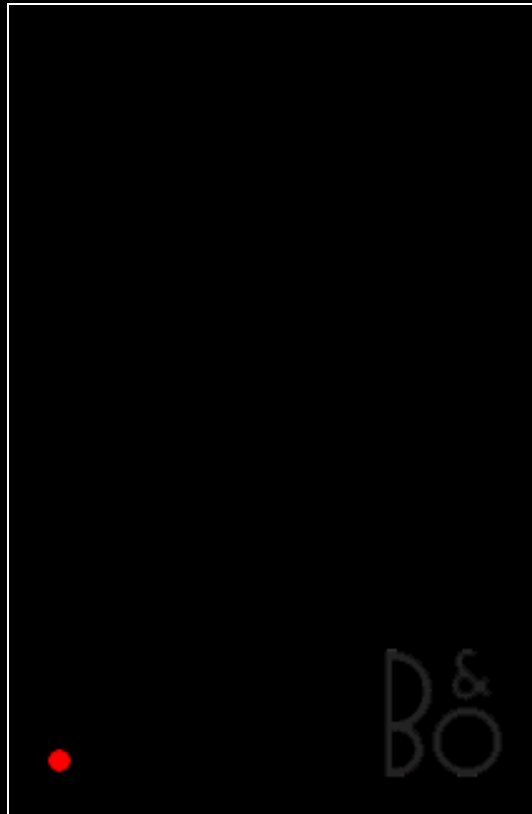
If you are not familiar with how to install and activate skins, please refer to the Tracker and Motorola guidelines on installing software.

MAIN SCREENS

The BEOMOTO skin consists of 7 main screens or pages as they are called in Tracker. Below is a walkthrough of each screen.

STANDBY SCREEN

This is the first screen you will see when activating the BEOMOTO skin.



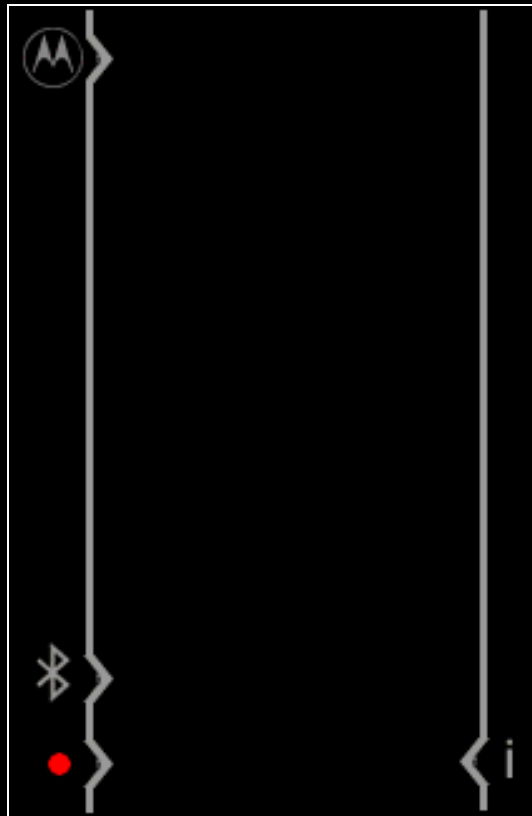
- Clicking the B&O logo shows information about BEOMOTO.
- Clicking the red dot activates the BEOMOTO skin.

The standby screen comes in handy when the phone is not used. It has no buttons that access any vital parts of your data, and the sleek design is a real show off on the table at your favourite café.

TIP! You can always, from anywhere in BEOMOTO, bring your handset to instant standby by clicking the red dot.

MAIN SCREEN

This is the screen you will see when activating the BEOMOTO from standby.



- Clicking the (M) Motorola logo causes a selection menu to open.
- Clicking the "B" Bluetooth logo opens your Bluetooth settings.
- Clicking the "i" button causes an information screen to open.

TIP! Clicking the (M) button anywhere in BEOMOTO always takes you back to the Main Screen.

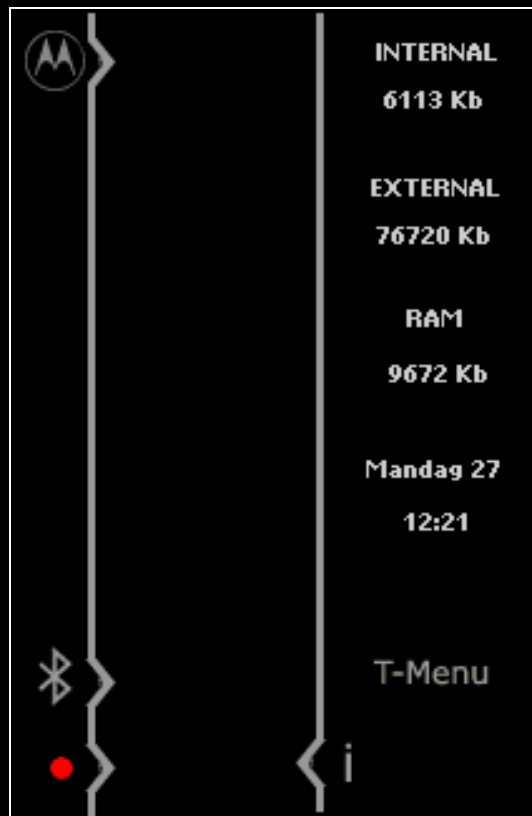
Program selection.

When clicking the (M) button the program menu opens. It contains 8 entries, each representing a program or a BEOMOTO function.



- Beosound is your system default audio player.
- Beovision is your system default video player.
- Beocom is your dialer / phone.
- Browse is your system default internet browser.
- Program is the BEOMOTO function to store shortcuts to applications.
- People is the BEOMOTO function to store shortcuts to contacts.
- Schedule is the BEOMOTO function to manage your appointments and tasks.
- Sticker is the BEOMOTO function to write notes, and store shortcuts to favourite content on the phone or on the internet.

Information screen

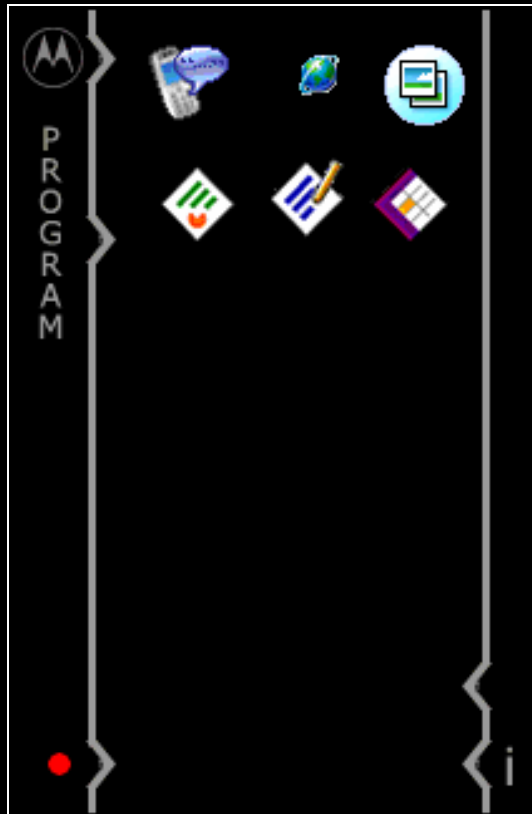


The information screen shows the remaining internal (handset), external (flashcard) and RAM (Work memory). It also shows the current date and time.

-Clicking the T-Menu button causes the full Tracker menu to open. From this you can choose between all Tracker functions.

PROGRAM

This is the screen you will see when selecting Program from the Main Screen. Use this screen to manage shortcuts to your applications.



Applications not included in BEOMOTO skin.

- Clicking the Program pane causes a popup menu to open.
- Clicking the "i" pane causes a bar menu to open.

The Program popup menu.

From this menu you can choose between four different pages to store shortcuts to programs on. Beocenter, Office, Amusement and Other.

Other is the page you see as default when opening Program from the Main Screen.

The "i" bar.

This is the bar from where you can modify the current Program page.



- Clicking the Add New button, causes the shortcut guide to open.
- Clicking the Tasks button, causes the Tracker tasklist to open.
- Clicking the Run Other button, opens a list of all available programs on the handset. Click any of these to start them, or click cancel in the bottom to go back to the bar.
- Clicking the "i" button causes the bar to close.

TO ADD A SHORTCUT TO A PROGRAM:

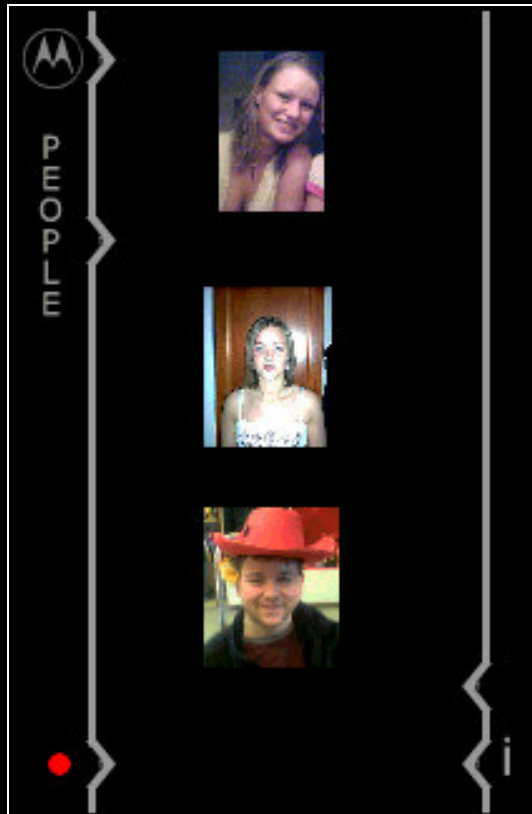
- Click the PROGRAM pane and select the page where you want to store the shortcut.
- Click the "i" pane to open the bar.
- Click Add New, and follow the instructions.
- Drag the shortcut icon to a desired position on the page.

TO REMOVE A SHORTCUT:

- Click the PROGRAM pane and select the page where the shortcut is located.
- Drag the icon to the pane just above the "i" pane. (A "D" occurs, meaning delete.)
- Confirm the dialog box asking if you are sure you want to delete the shortcut.

PEOPLE SCREEN

This is the screen you will see when selecting People from the Main Screen. Use this screen to manage shortcuts to your contacts.



Contacts not included in BEOMOTO skin.

- Clicking the Program pane causes a popup menu to open.
- Clicking the "i" pane causes a bar menu to open.

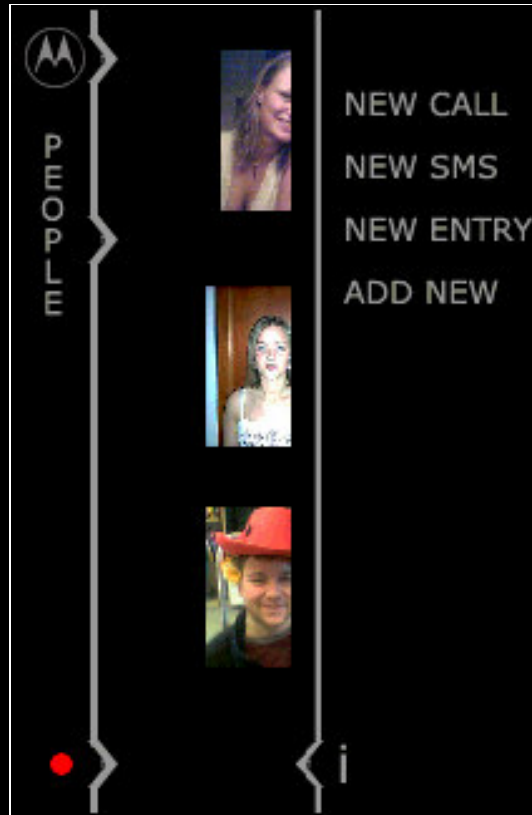
The People popup menu.

From this menu you can choose between five different pages to store shortcuts to contacts on. Business, Family, Friends, Blackbook (yes, a mistress list that is) and Other.

Other is the page you see as default when opening Program from the Main Screen.

The "i" bar.

This is the bar from where you can modify the current People page.



- Clicking the New Call button, causes the Dialer/Phone to open.
- Clicking the New SMS button, causes the SMS application to open, and a new SMS created.
- Clicking the New Entry button, causes the contacts application to open and a new contact created.
- Clicking the Add New button, causes the shortcut guide to open.
- Clicking the "i" button causes the bar to close.

TO ADD A SHORTCUT TO A CONTACT

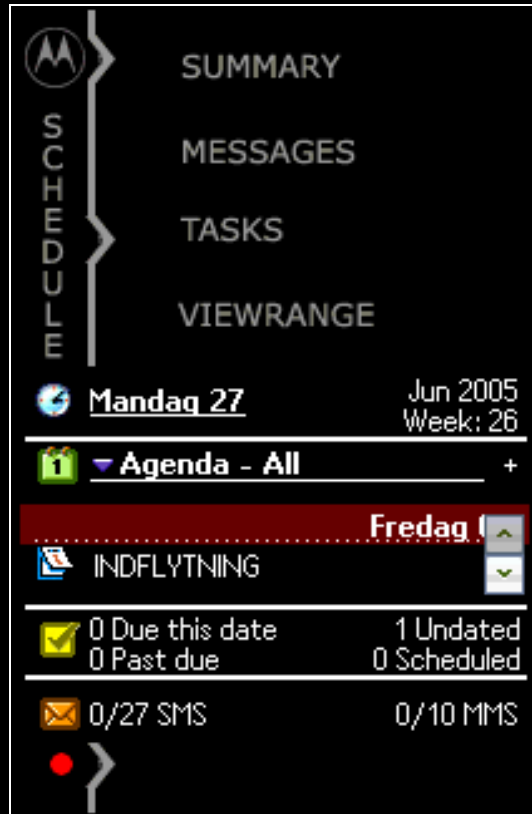
- Click the PEOPLE pane and select the page where you want to store the shortcut.
- Click the "i" pane to open the bar.
- Click Add New, and follow the instructions (You can choose whether the shortcut should be for speed dial, speed sms, mms, etc. NOTE: Only contacts with picture can be used) .
- Drag the shortcut icon to a desired position on the page.

TO REMOVE A SHORTCUT:

- Click the PEOPLE pane and select the page where the shortcut is located.
- Drag the icon to the pane just above the "i" pane. (A "D" occurs, meaning delete.)
- Confirm the dialog box asking if you are sure you want to delete the shortcut.

SCHEDULE SCREEN

This is the screen you will see when selecting Schedule from the Main Screen. The Schedule screen contains the Tracker today module. This module allows you to access your calendar, tasks and messages.

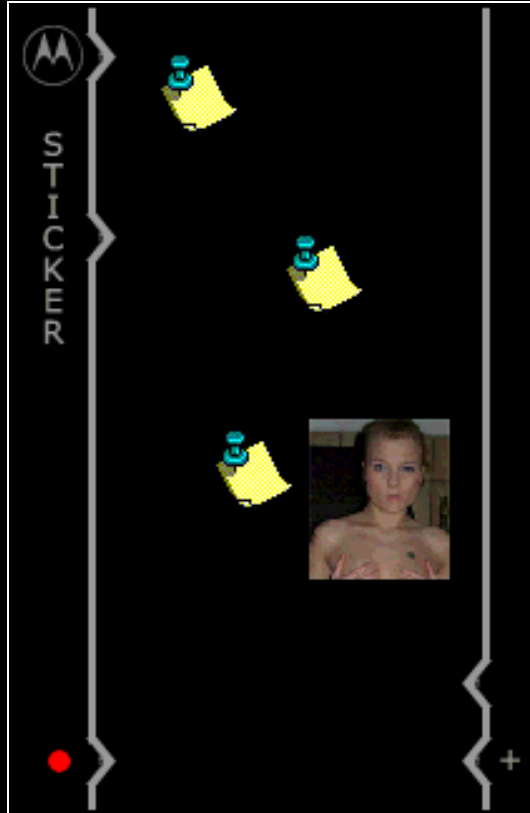


- Clicking the Summary button causes the today module to show a summary of current and upcoming events, tasks, and a sum of messages.
- Clicking the Messages button causes the today module to show your SMS inbox. The inbox is shown in the Schedule Screen, without leaving BEOMOTO.
- Clicking the Tasks button causes the today module to show a list of your tasks.
- Clicking the Viewrange button causes the today module to cycle between it's various screens. Besides from the above mentioned, the today module also shows a week and month view of your calendar.
- Clicking the Schedule pane causes a popup menu to open. From this menu you can make a new; appointment, task, message (email) or voicenote.

For information on how to use the today module, please refer to your Tracker documentation.

STICKER SCREEN

This is the screen you will see when selecting Sticker from the Main Screen. Use the Sticker screen to store notes and your favourite mobile or online content.



Notes not included in BEOMOTO skin.

- Clicking the Sticker pane causes a pop menu to open. From this menu you can choose between Notes and Favourites. On the Notes page, you can only store notes. On the Favourites you can store any content. The notes page is the default when opening Sticker from the Main Screen.
- Clicking the "+" button causes the new note dialog to be opened when the note page is active.
- Clicking the "+" button causes the new shortcut dialog to be opened when the favourites page is active.

TO REMOVE A NOTE OR SHORTCUT:

- Click the STICKER pane and select the page where the shortcut or note is located.
- Drag the icon to the pane just above the "+" pane. (A "D" occurs, meaning delete.)
- Confirm the dialog box asking if you are sure you want to delete the shortcut or note.
